Current State Of The Syllabus And ISTQB Certifications

- Over 160,000 foundation levels testers worldwide!
 - Just passed the 10,000 mark in the USA.
- Advanced exams were introduced in 2004.
- Current syllabus is 2007 version.
- Approximately 450 advanced certified in the USA.
 - Only 27 full advanced certifications.
 - More Advance Test Manager holders than any other in the USA.






The Value of Advanced Certification

- It is a further "setting apart" in the rather large and crowded field of software testing.
- Provides an in-depth framework for testing knowledge.
- Is a stepping stone for expert level certification.
- All of this contributes to learning our craft, profession or livelihood better.









Explaining Each of the Advanced Certifications

- We'll look at each of the three:
 - Advanced Test Manager
 - Advanced Test Analyst
 - Advanced Technical Test Analyst



Advanced Test Manager

- Define the overall testing goals and strategy for the systems being tested
- Plan, schedule and track the tasks
- Describe and **organize** the necessary activities
- Select, acquire and assign the adequate resources to the tasks
- Select, organize and lead testing teams
- Organize the communication between the members of the testing teams, and between the testing teams and all the other stakeholders
- Justify the decisions and provide adequate reporting information where applicable





Advanced Test Analyst

- **Structure the tasks** defined in the test strategy in terms of business domain requirements
- Analyze the system in sufficient detail to meet the user quality expectations
- Evaluate the system requirements to determine domain validity
- Prepare and execute the adequate activities, and report on their progress
- Provide the necessary evidence to support evaluations
- Implement the necessary tools and techniques to achieve the defined goals



Advanced Technical Test Analyst


- Structure the tasks defined in the test strategy in terms of technical requirements
- Analyze the internal structure of the system in sufficient detail to meet the expected quality level
- Evaluate the system in terms of technical quality attributes such as performance, security, etc.
- Prepare and execute the adequate activities, and report on their progress
- Conduct technical testing activities
- Provide the necessary evidence to support evaluations
- Implement the necessary tools and techniques to achieve the defined goals





More About the Syllabus, Topics and Timings

- The 2007 syllabus is one document with learning objectives and content for all 3 certifications.
- The general timings for courses is 5 days for each certification.
 - However, there is redundancy between the three areas, so there is accommodation for a 2 day core, plus 3 days for each of the three certifications





Prerequisites

- Experience: 3 years of verifiable full-time experience in software or systems testing, development, quality assurance, engineering or a related field,
- Certification Prerequisite: ISTQB Certified Tester, Foundation Level (CTFL)

About the Exam

- 65 multiple-choice questions.
 - Some simple
 - Others based on a longer scenario
- 3 hours to take the exam.
- Score of 65% or more is passing at present
- Available as:
 - paper-based exam (public course or in-house)
 - electronic exam (at a Kryterion exam center.)
- \$200 for each advanced exam
- \$100 one-time qualification fee



Going Beyond Advanced Certification

- Expert certifications are being released:
 - Expert test manager
 - Improving the test process
- Others are in development:
 - Test automation
 - Security testing
- One or more advanced certifications are required, depending on the expert certification.





Where to Start

- It depends!
- Most people start with either Advanced Test Manager or Advanced Test Analyst.
- Few people hold (or need) all three.
- Pick the one that best aligns with your job or future goals.







How to Prepare

- Option 1 No preparation
 - Not recommended
- Option 2 Textbooks
 - Inexpensive
- Option 3 Public and in-house courses
 - Intense courses of 5 days with a test at the end
 - Or, 2+3+3+3
- Option 4 E-learning
 - At your own pace
- Option 5 Self-study with mentoring
 - 12 weeks.
 - You prepare on your own with weekly expert guidance.
 - Saturation approach vs. rapid immersion
